St. Bonifacius has a long and rich history of German families coming together and working hard to build a community.

That history has been saved only in fragments as individual families keep bits and pieces of the family history. There has never been a central, organized effort to compile a history of St. Bonifacius. Pieces of the history are being lost as those who remember the early years die and families discard records that are of no importance to them.
